Itinerary

Day 1 Friday, July 11

Depart JFK via Air France at 6:00pm. Change flights in Paris before continuing to Rome.

Day 2 Saturday, July 12 Rome

Arrival in Rome at approximately 12:15pm. Assistance and transfer to Hotel Albani. Remainder of the day at leisure.

Day 3 Sunday, July 13 Rome

Breakfast. Morning tour of Villa Borghese. The rest of the day at leisure in Rome.

Day 4 Monday, July 14 Florence

Breakfast. Leave baggage in storage at hotel. Meet guide at the Vatican to for a 4 hour tour to visit the Vatican Museum, Sistine Chapel and St Peter's Basilica. Group entrance will be between 8:00am and 9:00am, the latest. Tour ends around 1:00pm. (Final confirmation of this tour is not available before 30 days of the visit. Confirmation is not guaranteed) Return to hotel on your own. 4:00pm transfer from hotel to Termini Station for departure by train to Florence. 2nd class seats with reservations. Arrival in Florence. Walk to Hotel Albani Firenze in Florence.

Day 5 Tuesday, July 15 Florence

Breakfast. At 9:00am meet guide at the Academia for 1 1/2 guided tour of the Academia. Leisure time until 3:00pm. At 3:00pm meet guide at the Uffizzi Gallery for 2 hour guided tour of the Uffizzi.

Day 6 Wednesday, July 16 Venice

Breakfast. Walk to the train station to take the morning train to Venice Santa Lucia. Second class tickets with reserved seats. Walk to hotel Villa Rosa on arrival.

Day 7 Thursday, July 17 Venice

Breakfast. At 9:30am meet your guide at St. Mark's Lion for a 90 minute guided tour including St Marco and the Doges' Palace. Afternoon at leisure until 4:00pm. Then proceed to train station for a short 30 minute ride to Padova. Visit Giotto's masterpiece at the Scrovegni Chapel. Return to Venice by train around 9:00pm

Day 8 Friday, July 18 Venice

Breakfast. Day on your own. You are free to explore Venice further or take excursions to the islands of Murano (glass blowing), Burano (handmade lace), Torcello (where Venice began), and Lido (beaches). Travel to sites not included in program cost.

Day 9 Saturday, July 19

Breakfast. Transfer to Marco Polo airport with assistance, leaving from Hotel Villa Rossa.

*****Students who are enrolled in ART 103 and are interested in participating in the Italy program must submit a completed application and a non-refundable \$250 deposit by February 15 to reserve their place. After February 15, 2008 registration will be open to the rest of the SJC community on a first come first serve basis.*****

All students who enroll in this program are expected to follow the group itinerary for the duration of the program.

Please be advised that all prices are based upon double occupancy. A single supplement will be offered for an additional \$360. All prices are based upon the value of the American Dollar and are subject to change.



Program Cost and Deadlines

The total cost for this program is \$2,799. A \$250 non refundable deposit must be received by 03/10/08. The remaining balance of \$2,549 must be paid by 04/07/08. Please make all checks payable to St. Joseph's College. On the memo line please write PGS Italy.
