Program Description

The Experience of a Lifetime

The Alicante Study Program offers students the opportunity to spend a month experiencing what they are learning. This opportunity will allow students to further their education through exposure to the history, art, and culture of Spain.

Program Costs

The program costs \$4,575. This price is subject to change due to increases in taxes and fuel charges at the time of ticketing.

Costs Include:

- 6 undergraduate credits through the University of Alicante
- Airfare to/from Alicante
- Housing with a Spanish host family
- 3 meals daily
- Airport/Hotel transfers in Alicante
- Orientation program with stay at a 3 star hotel
- Day trip to Elche and Murcia
- Weekend trip to Granada
- All other excursions

Eligibility

This program is open to St. Joseph's College students. Students from other institutions may be eligible. No prior foreign language requirement needed. Space is limited. Reserve your spot as soon as possible.

Courses

Beginner

This course is equivalent to the first two semesters of university level instruction. For true or quasi-true beginners.

Intermediate

This course is equivalent to the 3rd and 4th semesters of university level instruction. For high-beginners and low-intermediates.



Advanced

This course is equivalent to the 5th and 6th semesters of university level instruction. For mid-intermediates to low advanced.

Superior

This course is for those students who have completed more than 5 semesters of university level Spanish. For mid-advanced and high-advanced levels.

Deadlines

The application and a non-refundable deposit of \$200.00 are due by February 11, 2008. The remaining balance of \$4,375 is due no later than March 13, 2008. The balance must be paid with two checks. The first check must be payable to the "Academic Language Institute" in the amount of \$3,400. The second check must be payable to "St. Joseph's College" in the amount of \$975. In order to guarantee your spot, enrollment in the program, and airline reservations, these deadlines must be met; there will be no extensions. Space is limited so reserve your spot today.
