EDUCATIONAL HOUSING SERVICES AT THE ST. GEORGE

TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF OCCUPANCY

The student must officially be enrolled in St. Joseph's College in order to be eligible for off-campus housing. The nine-month agreement, from August 24, 2019 through May 25, 2020, will remain in effect until: (a) the agreement is terminated by the College; (b) student graduates; (c) the student violates College policies or regulations. Each room shall initially be delivered by Educational Housing Services (EHS) in broom-clean condition. During the period that the rooms are occupied by students, EHS shall (a) make sure all building systems remain in good working order; (b) provide cold and hot water, electricity, a/c, microwave, refrigerator, color cable T.V., wireless internet access and all necessary repairs, and (c) make sure the rooms otherwise comply with all requirements of governmental entities having jurisdiction over the rooms, including, without limitation, the requirements set forth in New York's warranty of habitability law as amended. SJC agrees that it will provide resident assistants (RAs) who will supervise and exercise authority over SJC students at the St. George.

Students are expected to conduct themselves in a manner that demonstrates due regard for their fellow residents. All rules of the residence halls must be followed, including those published in the EHS Residence Hall Student Handbook.

CANCELLATION/TERMINATION OF AGREEMENT

Two weeks prior to the first day of classes, the agreement may be canceled by notifying the coordinator of Off-Campus Housing in writing, and 100 percent of the room charge less the \$500 Housing Deposit for that semester will be refunded to the student. After the first day of classes, there will be NO REFUNDS for any reason.

INSURANCE

All resident students must be covered by family health insurance that is accepted in New York state. Neither SJC nor EHS assumes any responsibility for the destruction or loss of money, valuables or other personal property belonging to students, or in students' custody, whatsoever, whether such destruction or loss occurs in the rooms, common areas, public areas, elsewhere in the St. George, in students' baggage, gear, etc. SJC recommends that students carry personal property insurance.

AMENITIES INCLUDED IN YOUR RESIDENCE AGREEMENT

Amenities at the St. George include: 24/7 security, Electronic Key Card entry, shuttle service to and from the SJC Brooklyn campus, free membership at a 75,000-square-foot health club, kitchen facilities, study pods, gameroom, card-operated Laundromat and high-speed internet access. This agreement does not include meals or a specific meal plan offered through SJC or EHS.
